

Create transcripts that work better on browsers & mobile devices

In 2012, OMTI released meTranscripts™, providing attorneys with transcripts that are designed to work natively on mobile devices, such as smart phones and tablets.

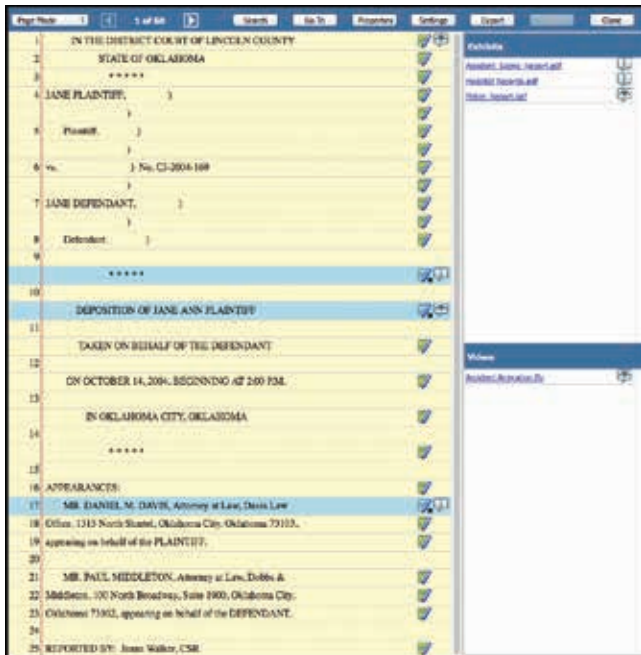
At the same time, we released RB8's Transcript Packages function, which bundles these new transcripts with all of their related files. Attorneys can view attached exhibits, videos and other files in context, in a browser just by tapping on links.

The Transcript Packages function is included free in RB8. Transcript Packages are readable in RB Web subscriptions, RB Web Mobile Apps and RB Web Mobile On™. In a browser, all bundled files are viewable. In the mobile versions of Transcript Packages, only meTranscripts are accessible.

Faster, more convenient for attorneys

Like RB-PDF transcripts, you can have hyperlinked exhibits in meTranscripts. Unlike PDF transcripts, linked files in Transcript Packages are not added into the transcript, keeping file size down and improving download speed.

When clients open a meTranscript in a browser, they can view any exhibit image in its native format by clicking a hyperlinked reference to it in the transcript. They do not have to maintain any additional files/file structure to access exhibits.



More productive for users

Users can:

- Easily write and share comments on meTranscripts with colleagues.
- Export their transcripts in full-size, condensed or AMICUS versions.
- Customize the appearance of exported transcripts.
- Email AMICUS versions to colleagues.
- Export any attached Word Indexes or Word Lists.
- Work on the same meTranscript across devices by syncing, so their notes appear whether they are on their laptop, smartphone or tablet.

Easier for production staff

If you are already providing RB-PDFs to your clients, your production staff will find the process of creating Transcript Packages familiar yet faster.

For example, the linking process in RB8's Transcript Packages function is similar to exhibit linking in RB8's PDF Transcript Creator. And Transcript Packages are created using the original ASCII file.

Even better is how Transcript Packages can save your production staff's time. They do not have to customize the appearance of transcripts. If your clients want their transcripts to look a certain way, they choose customization options when exporting from Transcript Packages in a browser or on their mobile devices.

Additional production efficiencies

Your production staff can:

- Search for transcripts to package by date uploaded.
- Attach ASCII files to transcripts.
- Save time linking exhibits if the files have a common root name by using Alias Patterns to copy the common name, then automatically append each file's number in its alias.
- Set preferences, such as frequently used Alias Patterns, that RB8 remembers each time.
- Batch process a day's worth of Transcript Packages at once.
- Notify clients automatically via email when their Transcript Packages are available.
